Conditions of Service

Training

1. As a member of 39 Army Cadet Unit you are required to attend programmed weekly parade nights of three hours duration, two weekend bivouacs and a seven day camp held during the September school holidays. The dates and activities are listed in this parade card.
2. Courses for promotion to JNCO, SNCO, WO and CUO rank are conducted for nominated cadets. Nominated cadets may be eligible to achieve the Adventure Training Award. Any Cadet may also participate in the Duke of Edinburgh's Award at an additional cost.

Discharge

3. A cadet is expected to serve for at least one year after enrolment. All cadets are required to inform the Officer Commanding in writing if they decide to leave the unit. All uniform and equipment issued must be returned by the cadet on leaving the unit or payment for the same will be required from the parents/guardians.

Leave

4. When a cadet is unable to attend any programmed activity they are obliged to notify the Unit as soon as possible. A leave form is available in hard copy from the orderly room or by logging into the members only section of the website. If you are unable to do either of these you can email the unit or leave a message on the unit phone number. Both of these are on the front of this parade card.

Fees

5. To cover costs not paid by the army, an annual fee is charged per cadet. The cost is \$100 per year and \$50 for a part year. These fees are vital for the efficient running of the unit. Fees are payable by cadets by 1 March and by recruits within three weeks of joining. If payment is a problem, then parents/guardians should approach the Officer Commanding or Adjutant to arrange a payment plan.

Uniform & Equipment

6. Upon enlistment a cadet is issued with uniform and equipment. The uniform, as directed, is to be worn to all parades unless otherwise notified. The uniform is **NOT** to be worn on any other occasion without prior approval from the Officer Commanding. The wearing of items of uniform with civilian attire is prohibited.
7. All unit members must take proper care of all items of uniform and equipment on issue.
8. The cadet must return all items of uniform and equipment on issue prior to discharge. Any items not returned must be fully paid for as they are the property of the Australian Government. Cadets' parents/guardians are liable for the cost of any lost or unreturned items.

Losses & Damages

9. Any loss or damage to uniform or equipment is to be reported to the Unit Quartermaster immediately. Loss caused by unfair wear or tear or damage is to be paid for by the cadet or their parents/guardians.

Illness or Injury

10. Any illness or injury sustained during training or when travelling to or from a parade activity is to be reported to the Unit Adjutant immediately.

Personal Occurrences

11. Unit members are required to update any change of circumstance such as change of address, telephone number, next of kin or medical condition online via COMS.

Security

12. Unit members are only to access the Barracks during approved unit activities. Cadets must be accompanied by an adult when arriving at the Barracks, and may only take public transport with permission from the Officer Commanding.
